Electrical Appliance Serviceperson

Becoming a registered Electrical Appliance Serviceperson allows you to:

- Maintain appliances that have an electrical rating of not more than 250 volts which are supplied by plug and flexible cord and
- Carry out testing of work described above and
- Carry out the certification of work described above and
- Supervise the above described work.

Electrical Service Technician

Becoming a registered Electrical Service Technician allows you to:

- Maintain fittings that are connected to conductors used in works or electrical installations and
- Carry out maintenance of appliances and
- Disconnect and connect fittings and appliances from and to a power supply other than by means of a plug or pin inserted into a socket, or an appliance coupler inserted into an appliance inlet for the purpose of the maintenance of those fittings and
- Carry out testing of work described above and
- Carry out certification of work described above and
- Supervise any work described above.

To enrol in the Electrical Service Technician course, you will need to provide evidence that you have successfully completed an Electrical Appliance Serviceperson course.

Examination and Practical Assessment fees are additional to the course cost.

The Electricity Act, The Electricity Safety Regulations and AS/NZS3760.

◇ One additional night for First Aid/CPR is for our EAS course in Auckland ONLY. This is not applicable for EST. If your safety refresher has expired since your EAS completion and you wish to apply for EST registration, you will need to book a separate First Aid/CPR course.

To be eligible for Registration by the EWRB you will need to have:

- Passed the Electrical Appliance Serviceperson or Electrical Service Technician written theoretical exam, practical assessments and;
- Completed 18 months practical training/experience in the work of an Electrical Appliance Serviceperson or Electrical Service Technician which is satisfactory to the EWRB. Electrical Service Technician practical training/experience must include at least six months training/experience on multi-phase appliances or fittings.
- Safety training including safe working practices, testing, First Aid and CPR.
